

Marion Vintage Power Farm Stock & Antique Pull Rules

1. Pull open to stock (no modifications) brand name tractors only. No attached tools (mowers, cultivators, loaders, etc.) Must be complete and in safe operating condition and equipped with rubber tires. No duals, four wheel drives. NO RADIALS in antique classes. Antique tractors must look stock from the factory. Single front wheeled tractors must have proven front ends from factory. All Tractors will not exceed 20% over stock RPM. Rear tires may be cut on top of bar only. No cutting to front of bar or into the casing. Kill switch must be on tractor; within drivers reach.
2. Drivers must obey flagman at all times, stay in seat, one hand on steering wheel and in full control of the tractor. NO bouncing in the seat, NO jerking the boat or transfer sled. Drivers must be 18 years old; or have parent or guardian permission and signature if under 18 years old. (Required) Minimum age to pull is 12 years old.
3. Tractors may be weighed 2 hours prior to pull, must re-weigh prior to each class pull. Tractors may jump class with a 5-minute call time. Limit one driver per tractor per class. Weight Classes: 2500# ←-----Rim height no bigger than 32" -----→ 2500#

4. Speed Limits: Farm Stock- 2.8 mph for 2500 & 3000# class; 3.5 mph for 4000, 5000, 6000, 7000 & 8000# class. No GPS's allowed. Antique-1st or 2nd gear only, no shifting Torque Amplifiers during Antique pull.
5. Weights will be securely attached. Rear weights may not exceed radius of rear tire or interfere with the hitching point. Rear weights can stick out no more than 6" on 28" rim or smaller. Front weights not more than 20 inches from farthest most front point of tractor. Weights may be relocated prior to pull. If weights fall off, the pull will be disqualified. NO weight added after tractor is on pull track; room is needed to measure hitches between weights.
6. Maximum hitching point is 18 inches (antique) and 20 inches (farm stock) with no change in design from original manufacture, except at clevis to obtain maximum correct height. Clevis will have a 3-inch opening not less than 24 inches from center of rear axle. Drawbar must be in fixed position. NO Johnson bars or vertical hitches. Hitch bracing will be allowed with bracing no closer than 8" on either side of hitch point.
7. Antique tractor classes limited to 1954 model or older.
8. Tractor may be checked by pull committee for safety and other points.
9. Tractor no more than 8 feet wide.
10. Contestants will not hold parties responsible for damages, injury, or theft at contest.
11. No alcohol or drugs to be consumed prior or during pulls.
12. JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL. Any un-sportsman like conduct; Puller will be barred from pull for remainder of season.

Open Classes limited to:

3500, 4500, 5500 or 6500#; with one of these classes being run per pull.
One hook only, with 50% payback to the winner.
